How to Submit

The Journal will consider submissions for the spring print publication (1,500-2,500 words) and online edition (800-1,500 words).

- Submit works for print publication by **Sunday, February 4, 2024, 23:59 CET**.
- Works for online publication accepted on a rolling basis.
- All submitted works will undergo a rigorous double-blind review.

Prior to submission, review submission guidelines below.

- Submit works by emailing submissions.saisjournal@gmail.com
- Send submission as a docx or doc file. PDFs will not be considered.
- All submissions must be original work, correctly citing all quotations and references.
- Citations must be in the form of endnotes following Chicago Manual of Style, 16th edition.
- Include a short bio of the author indicating current institutional affiliation, not exceeding 100 words. Multiple authors for a single piece are accepted.
- Submitted articles must be previously unpublished work. We will not publish an article that has already been accepted at other journals.
